What is fasting?

Fasting by definition means to abstain from food and drink. It is a deliberate denial of all foods, or choice foods for a determined amount of time. For example, Daniel fasted for 21 Days abstaining from the Kings table of meat and wine (Daniel 10:3), whereas, Moses didn't eat or drink anything for 40 days and nights, according to Exodus 34:28. From both examples, we find fasting to be the expression and cultivation of dependence on and humility before God. Denial of the natural, the flesh, in pursuit of the spiritual, our Father, actually moves the heart of God towards His people. Thus, fasting is a crucial part of a healthy relationship with God. Though fasting is not considered a major tenet of faith, Jesus intimates that His followers would fast, saying in Matthew 6:16: "... when you fast". Thus, when believer's fast and pray there is a profound spiritual impact in a person's individual life and in the community of God's people.

Why fast?

God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble (James 4:6-10). We're told in Isaiah 57:15, "I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with him who is of a contrite and lowly spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly, and to revive the heart of the contrite." The reference in Isaiah 66:1-2 is much the same as God looks at those who truly fear Him.

Our God, and Father, who is above all earthly power comes close to those who willingly humble themselves before Him because they acknowledge and recognize His Sovereignty. And, fasting is how we humble ourselves before God (Joel 1:14; 2:12, 15), it's how we revere Him above everything and anything else. By going without our most basic need for a set amount of time, we declare to God that He is more significant than any worldly possession. Simultaneously, in the absence of food, we look to Him as our sustenance. By fasting we are choosing to feed our spirit rather than our flesh. Fasting is one way that we demonstrate our utter dependence on God for all things. It is another level of yielding to His Lordship or leadership, beyond words but with action as we spend time in His presence declaring our need of Him. And in response, God comes closer to His people.

As God draws close to us in our humility, a fervency grows within the believer's heart. There is a desperation for God that increases (cf. Acts 13:2); freedom from besetting sins comes as our flesh is made subject to the written Word of God (Galatians 6:8; Romans 8:13); clear insight into God's will comes (cf. Acts 14:23); and, dramatic intervention comes in circumstances (see many examples below under "When should I fast").

How should I fast?

The Bible actually has a lot more to say about how *not* to fast rather than how to fast. The warnings are offered so that our fasting is pleasing to God and not just piety at work. For example, the Pharisee's fasted as a legalistic badge of merit and superiority, so we're told not to fast like that. We shouldn't let everyone know we're denying ourselves (exaggerated, distressed gasps as your friends eat lunch; complaining repeatedly about how hungry you are and the like are what Jesus is referring to in Matthew 6:16-18). God's people in the Old Testament are likewise condemned for fasting because they took advantage of others, so we're told what a true fast actually is, in God's eyes (Isaiah 58). God condemns people for fasting to get what they want, rather than merely drawing close to God and leaving the "results" to Him (" ... you seek your own pleasure." v. 3). So, when we fast, we should also pursue righteousness. And that means, loving others. Anything else is hypocrisy.

Who should fast?

According to a first century document called the *Didache*, almost all of the earliest Christians fasted as a regular rhythm in their lives together (they fasted every Wednesday and Friday). Furthermore, Jesus says that His disciples will fast as an act of grief for His departure and as an act of longing for His return (Matthew 9:14-15). As such, it is fitting for Christians to appropriate this powerful means of grace life. To shrink away from this practice is to refuse what God may want to accomplish in and through the process.

When should I fast?

The Scriptures are rife with examples of when God's people are to fast. Nehemiah fasted for an astounding 120 days when he saw the state of God's people and God's city (Neh 1:1-4). Esther called for the entire nation of Israel to fast as she tried to divert Haman's plan to annihilate the Jews (Esther 4:15-17). Ezra proclaimed a fast in order to seek God's protection when the people returned from exile to rebuild Jerusalem (Ezra 8:21; similarly: 2 Chronicles 20:3). The Apostles fasted when they needed clarity on God's plan in the early days of the Church (Acts 13:2-3; 14:23). Even Jesus fasted for 40 days at the outset of His ministry to declare His complete dependence on the Father (Matthew 4). Given these examples, we can conclude that fasting is especially appropriate when God's intervention is especially needed.

Let's get practical ...

- Prepare for your fast by slowing down the amount of food you eat, and/or the
 portion size and/or the kinds of foods you intake a couple of days before your
 official day of fasting begins. Avoid high-fat and sugary foods before beginning
 a fast. Wean yourself from caffeine before fast begins.
- Consult your physician if you're on medication. And, you might talk to him/her about a recommended multivitamin and/or fiber supplement. If you are diabetic, have a serious heart condition or are pregnant, you probably should not fast
- You can fast in many ways. A whole fast speaks to no food and all liquids. A
 half fast may be the kinds of foods you eat or the time of day. For instance, you
 may fast from 6am-6pm eating nothing or eating vegetable or eating regularly
 at 6pm. Any combination of eating may be considered a half fast. Pray about
 what kind of fast you will engage.
- To prevent constipation during and after the fast, eat fresh fruit and raw vegetables, fruit and/or real vegetable juices. Watch sugar content in many juices. Odwalla and Naked juices are loaded with sugar, for instance. Stay away.
- The first three days are almost universally the most difficult. The body is
 releasing toxins that have been built up for years. Once you're through the
 fourth day, your equilibrium will return and you'll likely feel surprisingly alert
 and strong. Drink plenty, plenty, plenty of water.

- Don't forget why you're fasting! We can easily get absorbed into recipe's and/or the physical effects of our fast that we forget to maximize its impact in extended times of prayer and taking in large doses of the Scriptures. Don't waste your fast.
- If you have had serious eating issues in the past, you should approach fasting with great caution. You may consider fasting from a particular type of food (meat, fruit, etc.).
- What about fasting from Facebook, TV, internet, etc? While these are
 admirable and even recommended practices, the Biblical definition of fasting is
 universally with respect to food. Nothing so thoroughly reminds us of our
 dependence on God than the denial of our most basic need ... and no, our most
 basic need is not Facebook.
- Have a clear prayer target/focus. And, write it down (Habakkuk 2:2). Without a
 vision or clear goal you cannot know clearly how God intervened at the
 conclusion of your fast. Maybe you'd like to see salvation for your relatives,
 maybe you'd like to see a situation change/resolve on your job.
- When you fast, sincerely pray. Read the Scriptures aloud (Matthew 4:4). It may seem obvious, but busyness and distractions can keep you from daily devotions. Expect to hear God's voice in the Scriptures, in dreams, vision and revelations. Daniel prepared himself to receive revelation through fasting (Daniel 10:1-2).
- There are times during a fast that there is an emotional cleansing. If you find yourself highly sensitive to different emotions, use the fast to identify those areas in life that need greater attention. Self control is necessary.
- End your fast gradually. Break the fast eating light meals and/or foods that are easy to digest (Broth, apple sauce, watermelon, steamed vegetables).
- Prepare for opposition. satan tempted Jesus and he will tempt you (Matthew 4)
- If you err and eat, breaking the fast before the 21 days have ended, don't live in condemnation. Start again.
- If you're joining the fast after it is underway, welcome! It's not too late!

Discussion Questions:

- 1. After reading this sheet, what do you find most motivating in what you've read?
- 2. Read Matthew 6:16-18. Why do you think Jesus assumes His followers will fast? Given what you've read, what "rewards" might God grant those who fast in this way?
- 3. Read Isaiah 58:1-12. What makes God so angry about this particular fast? What is the fast that God has chosen? What are some of the results when we fast in this way (properly)?
- 4. What sort of fast are you going to pursue (water only, juice only, one meal a day)?

DAY 1 – AUGUST 4

Personal – 5am to 8am

BE OPEN BEFORE GOD

Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and said to the disciples, "Sit here while I go and pray over there. "And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and He began to be sorrowful and deeply distressed. Then He said to them, "My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Stay here and watch with Me." (Matthew 26:36-38)

- 1. Thank God for the opportunity to come before Him just as you are; bless His name for counting you worthy to experience His grace and mercy today.
- 2. Commit yourself to God and ask Him to search you completely; pray that the Lord will reveal all your anxieties and weaknesses in your heart to you today.
- 3. Confess your sins, worries, doubts and fears to God and ask Him to help you trust in Him; ask for help to draw closer to Him in humility, honesty and openness.

Family and Church – 8am to 11am

- 4. Present your entire family to God and ask Him to draw them close to Himself; pray that your family will be willing to enjoy fellowship with Him this season.
- 5. Pray that your family will seek the Lord honestly as you intercede for them during the 21 days of fasting and prayer; declare that they will seek Him diligently and find Him in this season.
- 6. Thank God for His presence and power at work in the church; pray for divine encounters in the church during this year's 21 Days of Power.

Productivity, Career and Business - 11am to 2pm

- 7. Present all your anxieties concerning your academics and work to God; ask Him to deliver you from them and give you clarity of thought to pursue your dreams.
- 8. Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you completely today; ask for God's grace to help you go about your business in honesty and transparency.
- 9. Bind and cast out every cycle of delay, defeat and disappointment from your life; declare that this year, you will see a turnaround in all your endeavors in Jesus' name.

Our Nation and Other Countries – 2pm to 5pm

- 10. Thank the Lord for His manifest glory over the body of Christ in America; pray that we will be sensitive to His leading and follow His precepts in all we do.
- 11. Commit our leaders to the Lord and ask Him to mold theirs heart and make it subject to His will; pray that they will walk in His precepts and abide by His principles.

12. Thank God for His grace available to you as we commence this year's 21 Days of Power; declare that every blessing tied to this year's fasting and prayers will accrue to you in Jesus' name.

Declaration – 8:30pm

Oh Lord my God, how excellent is your name in all the earth. Lord, You have searched my heart and known my thoughts and ways. You have tried me and known my weaknesses. Reveal Yourself to me in this season as I wait on You, show me Your ways that I may walk with You all the days of my life. I declare that my mind is set on You from today in Jesus' name, Amen!

DAY 2 – AUGUST 5

Personal – 5am to 8am

THANKSGIVING

"Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name." (Psalms 100: 4)

- 1. Thank God for His grace, mercy, protection and provision over your life; bless His name for all He has done for you and your family.
- 2. Praise God for the strength He has given you to both start and finish the 21 days of fasting and prayer in power.
- 3. Bless the Lord for the wisdom He has given you and His ability to fulfil all His promises towards you during the 21 Days of Power.

Family and Church – 8am to 11am

- 1. Celebrate the Lord for His good plans for you and your family; thank Him for delivering your family from evil and giving you victory over every limitation.
- 2. Thank God for the joy He has bestowed upon you and your family this year; declare that the joy of the Lord will strengthen and keep you from evil.
- 3. Praise the Lord for all the miracles, signs and wonders He has prepared for the body of Christ throughout this year's 21 Days of Power.

Productivity, Career and Business – 11am to 2pm

- 7. Thank God for His favor upon your career and business; declare that you will flourish and be a thousand times more in all your endeavors.
- 8. Thank God for His blessings over the work of your hands; declare that you have entered into your season of divine provision and abundance.

9. Declare that the Lord will make you fruitful in your core areas of business; pray that every investment into your business will yield profits in Jesus' name.

Our Nation and Other Countries- 2pm to 5pm

- 10. Thank God for His love over your country and pray that He will stir up growth in every sector of your country's economy.
- 11. Glorify God for all the blessings He has prepared for the nation as we lift our voices in prayer during the 21 days of fasting and prayer; declare that every plot of chaos, war and disaster will not prosper in Jesus' name.
- 12. Bless the Lord for His peace over all the nations of the world; pray that His abiding presence will continue to be with America.

Declaration – 8:30pm

I will call upon the Lord, for He is worthy to be praised. I will offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving and give my heart to Him. Today, I receive divine strength to start and finish the 21 Days of Power in the fullness of God's might. I declare that every promise tied to my obedience accrues to me in Jesus' name. **Amen!**

DAY 3 – AUGUST 6

Personal – 5am to 8am

- 5. Ask God to renew the minds, thoughts and ideas of every member of your family from worldly and temporary things and set them on eternal and godly things that bring Him honor.
- 6. Ask the Lord to consecrate the church and lead her in righteousness and purity; pray that every believer will desire to live a holy and acceptable life unto Him.

Productivity, Career and Business – 11am to 2pm

- 7. Surrender the work of your hands to the Lord and dedicate to Him every office space and equipment you use in executing your tasks.
- 8. Receive God's grace and wisdom to positively influence decisions and persuasions at your workplace.
- 9. Ask the Lord to connect you to your destiny helpers and partners who will help you grow in productivity in your career or business.

Our Nation and Other Countries - 2pm to 5pm

- 10. Pray for a massive outpouring of the Holy Spirit into the body of Christ and ask God to renew the hearts and minds of every believer across the nation.
- 11. Pray for the righteousness of God to be exalted over all the nations of the world as we dedicate them to Him today.
- 12. Thank God for a nationwide consecration as we commit every town, city, and region to Him; pray that people will have divine encounters as they go about their daily lives.

Declaration – 8:30pm

In the name of Jesus, I declare that I am more than a conqueror. Today, I boldly confess that I am the righteousness of God; as He is in heaven, so am I on earth. I am set apart for God's own purpose. Therefore, I will walk in truth and uprightness. I will wait on the Lord for He is my salvation. **Amen!**

DAY 4 – AUGUST 7

Personal – 5am to 8am

ANOINTING

- 9. Ask God for the anointing and resources to complete every business project that has delayed.

Our Nation and Other Countries – 2pm to 5pm

- 10. Ask the Lord to anoint the leaders in your country with wisdom to deal with every social, economic and political issue that hinders national development.
- 11. Commit the country to the Lord and ask Him to raise leaders anointed with unique gifts and skills to drive economic development.
- 12. Ask the Lord to clothe the America with power from on high and anoint us for victory in Jesus' name.

Declaration – 8:30pm

Productivity, Career and Business – 11am to 2pm

- 7. Ask the Lord to give you wisdom to be productive and committed in your chosen field as you continue to build your career and business on Christ the solid rock.
- 8. Declare that your trust will remain in the Lord alone; ask Him to guide you in your career and business to escape partnerships which will bring losses.
- 9. Pray that the Lord will help you to go about your business with godly principles and wisdom, and not with worldly wisdom.

Our Nation and Other Countries – 2pm to 5pm

- 10. Pray that the Holy Spirit will saturate the body of Christ in America and cause believers to hold fast to the gospel in Jesus' name.
- 11. Pray that Christian missionaries in America will remain committed to their work and that the Lord will deliver them from afflictions, persecutions and tribulations.
- 12. Pray that the name of the Lord shall be lifted up all over the world; ask the Lord to release His Spirit of favor in areas where Christianity is being persecuted.

- 7. Bless the Lord for this season of power and pray that your career and business will enjoy grace and favor to flourish and be profitable.
- 8. Praise the Lord in advance for all the business opportunities you will enjoy this year; declare a season of growth and prosperity in your business in Jesus' name.
- 9. Boldly declare that all things will work together for your good; receive divine ability to excel in all your endeavors.

Our Nation and Other Countries – 2pm to 5pm

- 10. Thank God for His mighty hand upon all the nations of the world; declare that He will reign in the affairs of governments and establish His will in all corridors of power.
- 11. Pray for an open heaven over the body of Christ globally; declare that God will protect and preserve all believers against evil plots and attacks.
- 12. Praise the Lord for all the victories He has won for you during this year's 21 Days of Power; declare that in all things, His praises shall continually be in your mouth.

Declaration – 8:30pm

I give You all the thanks and praise, O Lord, for Your goodness and mercies endures forever. I will bless the Lord at all times and His praise shall continually be in my mouth. I declare that the Lord is my sword and shield, He is the source of my strength, He is my glory and the One who lifts my head. I will ever trust Him because He is my light and my salvation. **Amen!**

DAY 7 - AUGUST 10

Personal – 5am to 8am

SANCTIFICATION

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service" (Roman 12:1)

- 1. Present yourself to God this morning and ask Him to cleanse you from all your sins; boldly confess that you are renewed and restored in fellowship in Jesus' name.
- 2. Ask the Lord to set you apart and strengthen you to live holy; pray that your life will be pleasing and acceptable to Him all the days of your life.
- 3. Dedicate yourself to the Lord and ask Him to manifest His glory and power through you as you wait on Him in fasting and prayer.

Family and Church – 8am to 11am

- 4. Commit your entire family to the Lord and ask Him to set them apart unto Himself; ask the Lord to establish His will in your family as you dedicate them to Him today.
- 5. Intercede for every member of your family caught in a snare of addiction and sin; pray for their deliverance and a supernatural turnaround in Jesus' name.
- 6. Present the body of Christ in your country to God and ask Him to consecrate her and make her a channel of hope for the lost and needy.

Productivity, Career and Business – 11am to 2pm

- 7. Come before the Lord in total surrender and ask Him to order all your decisions in career or business in accordance with His Word.
- 8. Ask the Holy Spirit to grant you the boldness to positively influence staff and coworkers that practice wrong doing in your workplace; pray that holiness will reign at your workplace in Jesus' name.
- 9. Ask God to speak to your heart and shape your thoughts and plans; receive grace and wisdom to be productive in all your endeavors.

Our Nation and Other Countries – 2pm to 5pm

- 10. Bind and cast out the reign of sin and vices among young people in your country; ask the Holy Spirit to convict people of sin and draw them unto Himself in total surrender.
- 11. Release God's grace over missionary activities in nations deeply entrenched in idolatry; pray for a massive revival and harvest of souls in Jesus' name.
- 12. Thank God for His mercy over the nation and in the world; and, pray that the nations of the world would experience God's glory.

Declaration – 8:30pm
