Daily Scriptures

Day 1 - (August 4) Isaiah 6:3 - "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Heaven's Armies! The whole earth is filled with his glory!"

Day 2 - (August 5) Exodus 15:11 - "Who is like you among the gods, O Lord—glorious in holiness, awesome in splendor, performing great wonders?"

Day 3 - (August 6) Psalm 99:9 - "Exalt the Lord our God and worship at his holy mountain, for the Lord our God is holy!"

Day 4 - (August 7) Leviticus 19:2 - "You must be holy because I, the Lord your God, am holy."

Day 5 - (August 8) Revelation 4:8 - "Each of these living beings had six wings, and their wings were covered all over with eyes, inside and out. Day after day and night after night they keep on saying, 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God, the Almighty—the one who always was, who is, and who is still to come.'"

Day 6 - (August 9) 1 Samuel 2:2 - "No one is holy like the Lord! There is no one besides you; there is no Rock like our God."

Day 7 - (August 10) Psalm 29:2 - "Honor the Lord for the glory of his name. Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness."

Day 8 - (August 11) 1 Peter 1:15-16 - "But now you must be holy in everything you do, just as God who chose you is holy. For the Scriptures say, 'You must be holy because I am holy.'"

Day 9 - (August 12) Hebrews 12:14 - "Work at living in peace with everyone, and work at living a holy life, for those who are not holy will not see the Lord."

Day 10 - (August 13) Romans 12:1-2 - "And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he

will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him. Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect."

Day 11 - (August 14) Ephesians 4:22-24 - "Throw off your old sinful nature and your former way of life, which is corrupted by lust and deception. Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes. Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy."

Day 12 - (August 15) 2 Timothy 1:9 - "For God saved us and called us to live a holy life. He did this, not because we deserved it, but because that was his plan from before the beginning of time—to show us his grace through Christ Jesus."

Day 13 - (August 16) Leviticus 20:26 - "You must be holy because I, the Lord, am holy. I have set you apart from all other people to be my very own."

Day 14 - (August 17) 1 Thessalonians 4:7 - "God has called us to live holy lives, not impure lives."

Day 15 - (August 18) Colossians 3:17 - "And whatever you do or say, do it as a representative of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through him to God the Father."

Day 16 - (August 19) 1 Corinthians 10:31 - "So whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God."

Day 17 - (August 20) Ephesians 4:25-32 - "So stop telling lies. Let us tell our neighbors the truth, for we are all parts of the same body. And 'don't sin by letting anger control you.' Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, for anger gives a foothold to the devil. If you are a thief, quit stealing. Instead, use your hands for good hard work, and then give generously to others in need. Don't use foul or

abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them. And do not bring sorrow to God's Holy Spirit by the way you live. Remember, he has identified you as his own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption. Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior. Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you."

Day 18 - (August 21) 1 Thessalonians 4:3-7 - "God's will is for you to be holy, so stay away from all sexual sin. Then each of you will control his own body and live in holiness and honor—not in lustful passion like the pagans who do not know God and his ways. Never harm or cheat a Christian brother in this matter by violating his wife, for the Lord avenges all such sins, as we have solemnly warned you before. God has called us to live holy lives, not impure lives."

Day 19 - (August 22) Galatians 5:22-23 - "But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!"

Day 20 - (August 23) Philippians 4:8 - "And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise."

Day 21 - (August 24) 2 Corinthians 7:1 - "Because we have these promises, dear friends, let us cleanse ourselves from everything that can defile our body or spirit. And let us work toward complete holiness because we fear God."
